Experience is the best teacher...especially when it comes to youth. I think that's why, today more than ever, parents are having their young ones try it all. Whether its golf, baseball, softball, piano, violin, or chess, there is something to be gained for a child's development - even at the sacrifice of calendars and parental sanity!

First Tee has always focused on youth and character development as its mission. The curriculum model shapes the participants experience by creating a fun and safe learning environment. By using core values as the foundation of the life skills lessons, children are given the tools to grow and build their character through on and off course experiences led by trained caring adults and mentors.

In 2023, all First Tee chapters will move to an age-based program that will be centered on First Tee's commitment to **Being a Game Changer**. The five Key Commitments are life skills we want our participants to adopt and pursue as they develop good character.

Pursuing Goals

Create excitement to grow and learn, don't be afraid to fail, learn from achievements and setbacks.

Growing Through Challenge

Discover strength, develop resilience, dig deep when things get tough.

Collaborating with Others

Respect others' opinions even when they are different than mine, show courtesy and kindness for others.

Building Positive Self-Identity

Find self-confidence, discover capabilities, feel safe to be one's own self.

Using Good Judgment

Respect the rules, be honest with one's self and others, have courage to do what's right.

With these exciting curriculum changes, the most noticeable one is how the classes are labeled. Class names such as PLAYer, Par, Birdie and Eagle will be replaced with age groups 7-9, 10-11, 12-13, and 14 & up. This will make it much easier for parents sign their child up for the correct class.

First Tee's commitment to provide programs that build character and instill life-enhancing values through the game of golf remains unchanged.

It is fitting that the First Tee provided our family with so many FIRSTS this fall. Nick found out in July 2022 that he was selected to play in the PURE Insurance Golf Championship Impacting First Tee. This meant he would need to travel to California to play golf at Pebble Beach and Spyglass Hill.

This would be Nick's FIRST time flying. When asked if he was nervous about the tournament, he responded, "not right now, I'm just nervous about flying." The next FIRST for all three of us was to visit the state of California. What an amazing place! We had beautiful weather, wonderful accommodations, and met with the nicest people. The most amazing FIRST was the golf. For a seventeen-year-old young man to have the opportunity to practice and play at such prestigious golf venues was a once in a lifetime experience. First Tee, PGATOUR Champions, Pure Insurance and



all the organizations involved treated these young golfers and their chaperones like royalty. The players left with a suitcase full of swag, including a new Taylor Made golf bag. They were fed well and often.

They were given opportunities to practice at the tournament facilities and play practice rounds at both Pebble and SpyGlass. Nick had his FIRST opportunity to play with a professional golfer.

2022 PGA Jr. League AllStars Finish 4th in Mid-Atlantic Section



During the summer, the Roanoke area PGA Junior League fielded four teams that included almost 50 players; three teams were hosted by First Tee and one was hosted by Blacksburg Country. After a great season, ten area players were selected for the Roanoke Valley All-Star Team. The All-Stars played their first match at The Dominion Club in Glen Allen, VA. As a team, they shot a score of 9 under par (96) to advance to the MAPGA Section Championship! After competing in the 2-day event at the University of Maryland Golf Course, the Roanoke Valley team finished 4th overall in the Mid-Atlantic Section and 1 shot shy of qualifying for the Regional Championship.
